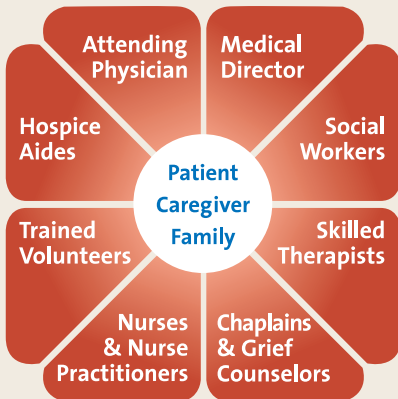
Who Is Eligible For Hospice?

The Hospice Benefit is available to anyone with a life expectancy of six months or less if the terminal illness or disease runs its normal course.

Hospice appropriate individuals may exhibit some or all of the following:

- Frequent hospitalizations
- Progressive weight loss
- Deteriorating mental abilities
- Recurrent infections
- Specific decline in condition

Rivercross has a unique Rapid Response Team that is easily accessible and provides immediate care for patients 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

How to Refer

- 1: Call Rivercross Hospice 24 hours a day, 7 days a week at the number listed on the back.
- 2: Our hospice team contacts all responsible parties to coordinate the family consultation and/or the patient assessments.
- 3: Our admission team consults, evaluates and initiates care, if appropriate and keeps you informed at all times.

HOSPICE DIAGNOSES INDICATORS*

Neurological (CVA, Parkinsons, ALS)

- Unable to ambulate alone
- ADL assistance required
- Limited speech
- Increased weakness
- Incontinent of bowel or bladder
- Weight loss

Renal Disease

- No longer receiving dialysis
- Confusion, obtundation
- Intractable nausea and vomiting
- Intractable fluid overload

Cardiac

- Shortness of breath with exertion
- Ejection fraction 20% or less
- Recurrent symptoms of CHF
- Activity intolerance
- Poor response to maximum medical management with diuretics and vasodilators

HIV

- Weight loss
- Decreased ability to care for self
- Chronic persistent diarrhea
- Changes in lab values

Dementia/ Alzheimer's

- Non-ambulatory
- Incontinent of bowel or bladder
- Recent hospital visits
- Recurrent infections
- ADL assistance required
- Lack meaningful verbal communication
- Weight loss

Adult Failure to Thrive

- Nutritional impairment/Weight loss
- ADL assistance required
- Increased Physician/ER visits
- Other co-morbidities

COPD/Lung Disease

- Hx of frequent ER visits, respiratory failure or infections
- Shortness of breath at rest
- Oxygen dependent
- Poor response to bronchodilators

Liver Disease

- Diagnosis of liver disease
- Abnormal liver enzymes
- Jaundice
- Ascites

** Indicators for receiving a hospice evaluation. Eligibility criteria will be applied during evaluation for hospice admission.*

- Respite Care
- General Inpatient Care
- Continuous Care
